Definition

A person experiences very specific genuine physical symptoms for which no physiological basis can be found

Symptoms

- Poor coordination or balance
- Abnormal movements
Paralysis or weakness
- Difficulty speaking or swallowing
- Retention of urine
- Loss of touch or pain sense
- Blindness or other visual symptoms
- Deafness
- Seizures, convulsions or "attacks"

Causes

The main cause for conversion disorder is a manifest of psychological Stress. Leading to sudden symptoms occurring all at once.
